# Before you begin

IN ORDER TO USE XPERTEYE ESSENTIAL, THE VUZIX M400 DEVICE MUST BE CONFIGURED. TO DO SO, CREATE QR-CODES USING A WEB BROWSER.

- XpertEye is compatible with Android, iOS, Windows, Linux and MacOS.
- Create QR-CODES using Google Chrome, Edge or Safari.

## A. Connecting the Vuzix M400 to the Internet

The Vuzix M400 device requires an Internet connection. The connection is created using a configuration QR-CODE.

If the device is already configured, go to section B - "Logging in to XpertEye Essential".

To create a configuration QR-CODE, open a web browser and go to the Server Region QR generator required (URLs provided in the "Before you begin" section) and select **Configuration**.



Select the Vuzix M400.










Take the frame and slide the device to one side and the battery to the other. Then, connect the USB-C/USB cable to the device and the battery. Press the power button at the back of the battery.

Warning: Only use the cable provided in the XpertEye Essential kit.





The device turns on automatically and the main menu appears. **Note:** Auto power on - 20 sec. When the Vuzix M400 battery is empty, the device will take 5 to 10 min to power on.



When the main menu appears, say "Hello Vuzix" to activate the voice commands, then say "Scanner".



### Note:

- You must say "Hello Vuzix" every time you leave XpertEye to reactivate voice commands.
- When using voice commands, speak loudly and clearly into the microphone. Pay attention not to cover the microphones with your fingers.

Scan the QR-CODE with the camera  $\square$  of the Vuzix M400 device pointing at the QR image. You can use the screen  $\boxtimes$  to ensure a proper view of the QR-CODE. A sound indicates that the QR-CODE is recognized.



Go back to the main menu by saying "Go home".



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After the QR-CODE is scanned, the Vuzix M400 device is connected to the Internet. The Wi-Fi icon at the top right of your screen is filled.

### Note:

- If the network is not connected, try to reconfigure the network using a new configuration QR-CODE, paying attention to the spelling and case of your Wi-Fi name and password or contact your IT department for assistance.
- The Wi-Fi setup needs to be performed once for each new network.



# B. Logging in to XpertEye Essential

A login QR-CODE is required to logging in to XpertEye Essential.

To create a login QR-CODE, open a web browser and go to the Server Region QR generator required (URLs provided in the "Before you begin" section) and select **Authentication**.



a. Enter username and password. If you do not know your login credentials, please contact your XpertEye administrator or IT department. b. Select your server region.

### Warning:

- Please make sure all users are on the same server region. Otherwise, contacts might not be seen as online.
- If experiencing stability issues when using the XpertEye solution on the GLOBAL server region with contacts located in Asia or Oceania, we recommend selecting the APAC server region.

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**Note:** To cancel previously created QR-CODES, enter username and password, click on **Invalidate previous QR-CODES** and confirm.

Click on **CREATE QR-CODE**.



For ease of use, **PRINT**, **EXTEND**, or **DOWNLOAD** the QR-CODE from the website.


On the Vuzix M400 device, say "Hello Vuzix" > "XpertEye".



Scan the QR-CODE with the camera  $\square$  of the Vuzix M400 device pointing at the QR image. You can use the screen  $\square$  to ensure a proper view of the QR-CODE. Once logged in to XpertEye Essential, you can call a contact or receive a call.

**Note:** You must scan the login QR-CODE every time XpertEye is launched.





# C. Switching off the Vuzix M400

Unplug the battery and press the power button  $\bigcirc$  for 2 seconds to switch off the Vuzix M400 device.

Press the button on the back of the Vuzix M400 device to confirm.

# D. Charging the Vuzix M400


- a. Connect the USB/USB-C cable to the Vuzix M400 device and charge it using a wall charger.
- b. Repeat this operation with the battery.

#### Note:

Vuzix M400 charging time: 2 hours

Green light: Charged

Blinking red light: Low battery



# E. Changing the Vuzix M400 language

### Note:

- Once in the Settings, voice commands are not longer functional.
- If you need help using the buttons, see the diagram on page 5.

### From the Vuzix main menu:

- Say "Hello Vuzix" > "Settings".
- Use the front button (from the screen) to go down to **System** and confirm by pressing the back button.
- Using the same buttons, select **Languages & input**.





- Select the language currently displayed, then select **Add language**.
- Select the language you wish to use, then confirm.
